She has served as the Secretary to the President for environment and has worked in various government committees as a member: the Ministry of Environment, the Ministry of Science, ICT and Future Planning and the Ministry of Strategy and Finance etc. In addition, she worked as a member of the Nuclear Safety and Security Commission and the National Commission on Sustainable Development.
